Uniform guide:

Blazers must be worn at all times around site. It is not acceptable to wear a jacket without a blazer. A Manor Academy branded school jumper may be worn underneath a blazer in cold weather. No other jumpers are allowed.

Shoes should be plain black shoes or boots. Trainers, plimsolls and canvas trainers are not acceptable:



No hoodies are allowed – hoodies are defined as cloth material with a hood, whether zipped or unzipped. If the material is waterproof it will be deemed an outdoor jacket, which is acceptable. Hoodies will be confiscated if seen on site and a consequence given.









Piercings

Only single stud piercings are acceptable. No other type of piercing is acceptable for health and safety reasons. Students will not be allowed in lessons if they are unable to remove unacceptable piercings and a consequence will be given if seen around site.



Equipment guide:

Bags should be able to hold an A4 folder. Anything that is unable to hold an A4 folder is not fit for purpose as knowledge organisers, which are expected equipment each day, are A4 in size.



Equipment should be held in a clear plastic pencil case. These can be bought cheaply at several outlets and online shops and can be bought fully stocked with equipment for less than £5. Only clear plastic pencil cases are accepted by exam boards when students are sitting exams.
